Question: will there be a staging area available for supply.

Question: Can light be reached from a ladder.

Answer: yes, lights in labs and offices can be reached by ladder 6-foot ladder for offices and 8-to-10-foot ladder for labs.

Question: will ballasts be staying.

Answer: No, we are going back with a direct wire light ballast bypass.

Question: would FDOT be interested in new fixture over retrofitting.

Answer: If new fixture is more cost effective on your quote that is fine.

Question: disposal of the current light bulbs and ballast

Answer: contractor will be responsible for the disposal of the current bulb and ballasts.

Question: completion date.

Answer: June 20, 2025.

Question: will contractor be responsible for sun damaged fixture or existing damage to fixture.

Answer: no contractor will not be responsible existing damage communicate and document existing damage with the project manager before making repairs to damage fixture
