Bills To Watch

HB 865 and SB 1118 – FDOT Bill

- Truck Weight Allowance – NGV
- FHWA risk based bridge inspection schedule
- Increase rapid response contracts to \$250K
- Optional validation of Turnpike Bonds
- Exempt emergency work amendments from LBC review
- Repeal FL Highway Beautification Council – create highway beautification program
- FDOT approval of South FL RTA expenditures using state funds



Bills To Watch

HB 17 – Local Preemption

- All local regulation of businesses, professions and occupations preempted to the state
- Affects – Rule, regulation, license, permit, requirement or associated fee
- Existing local rules, requirements, etc. expire on July 1, 2020.
- To have local controls, must have general law authority.
- In 2nd committee (of two)
- SB 1158 is similar – not going anywhere so far



Bills To Watch

SB 144 – Texting While Driving

- Called “Use of Wireless Communications Devices While Driving”
- Three bills related to texting while driving – this one is moving
- In 3rd committee (of three)



Bills To Watch

HB 221 – Transportation Network Co's

- The Uber/Lyft Bill
- Statewide requirements – preempts local requirements
- No ability of locals to regulate or collect revenue
- Before the full House
- Companion Bill SB 340
- On 3rd committee (of three)



Bills To Watch

SB 460 – Personal Delivery Devices

- Microwave sized device to operate on sidewalks
- Doorstep Delivery
- In 3rd committee (of three)
- Companion Bill HB 601
- Before the full House



Bills To Watch

SB 596 – Utilities

- Called “Advanced Wireless Infrastructure Deployment Act”
- Prohibits local governments from stopping the placement of small cell towers in the ROW or on utility poles. Exempts FDOT from the legislation (Authority definition)
- May charge up to \$15 per pole per year
- In 3rd committee (of three)

- HB 687 is similar – Affects FDOT
- In 2nd committee (of two)

Passed the Senate

Companion Bill in House

- Passed the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee
- Next Stop is for the Full House
- House Bill vs. Senate Bill

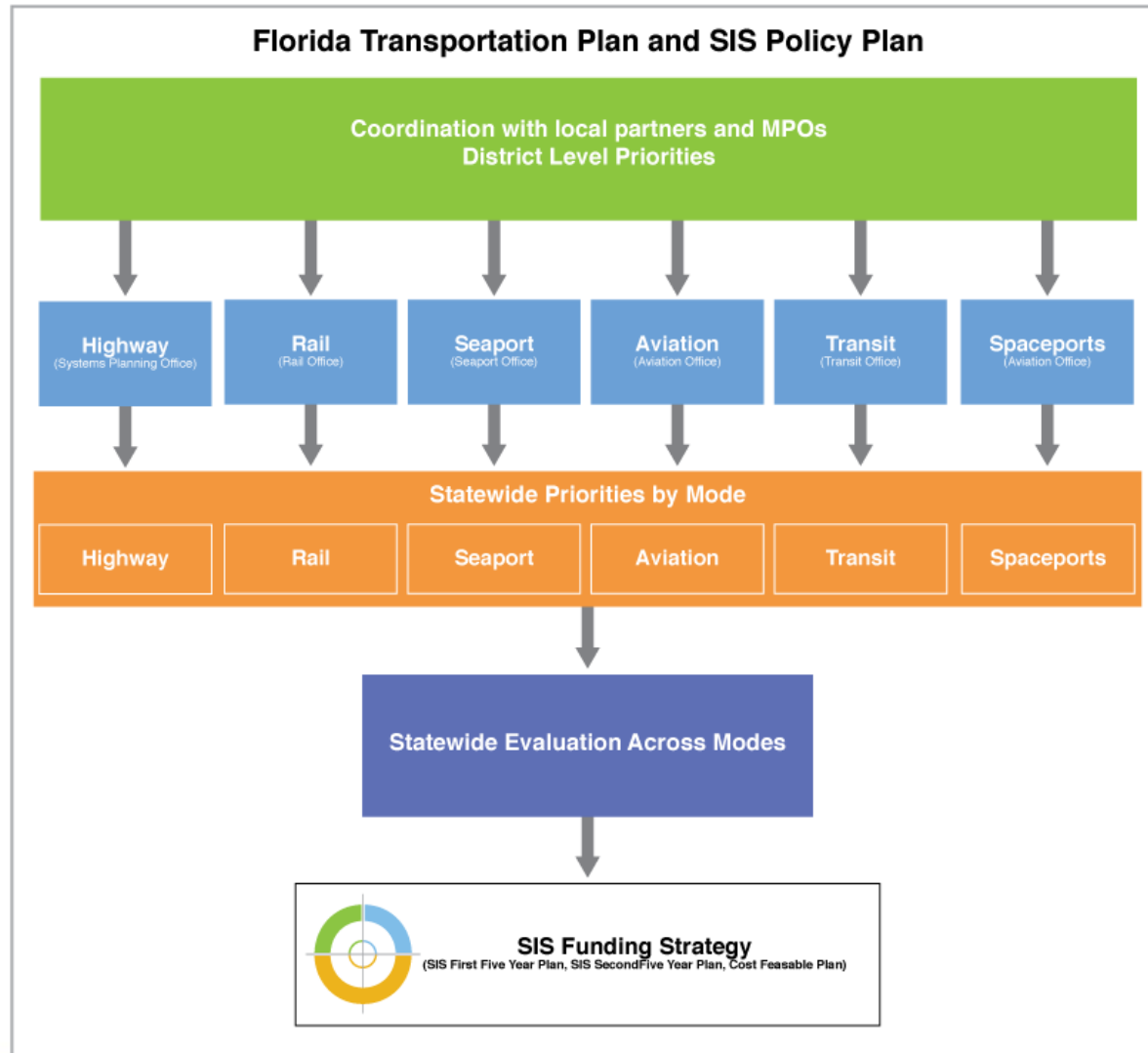


Total SIS Designations
